CLASSES: All classes begin promptly at 08:30 students **must** arrive to class on time. Students having excessive tardies will be dismissed from the Summer School program and will not receive academic credit for attendance (See Attendance Policy). All HS/MS recovery courses will be taught online using Edgenuity online program and must be completed before the end of Summer School for academic credit to be awarded

ATTENDANCE: Attendance at JCMHS Summer School is mandatory for students who elect to take courses on campus. Any student absent from class for a second time will be dismissed from Summer School program and will not receive academic credit for attendance. (See Attendance Policy)

DISCIPLINE: Students attending Summer School on campus are expected to behave appropriately at all times. Any student receiving a discipline referral or violating any JCSD behavior rule will be dismissed from the JCMHS Summer School program and will not receive academic credit for attendance. **There will be no second chance given!**

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COURSES

HS/MS: Courses can only be taken on campus students must be present and on time each day. Transportation and course seating for summer school are contingent on availability and space. Due to funding the only courses offered for Summer School 2015 are:

- 1) Algebra 1 (Remediation/Recovery)
- 2) Biology (Remediation/Recovery)
- 3) Reading Remediation
- 4) Math Remediation

Note: Students will just take 1 course that will run from June 10th to July 15th from 08:30 to 12:30. Students must be present for all classes each day, there are no exceptions to this rule.

For all students, except ESE ESY, Summer School attendance on campus is contingent upon seat availability and transportation availability. ESE/ESY course enrollment is based on IEP authorization.

Jefferson County Middle High School is excited to offer its annual Summer School Programs for grades 6-12. Classes will be held June 10th through July 15th, Monday through Thursday from 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 P.M., with the exception of the July 4th holiday.

Parents and students are encouraged to discuss summer school enrollment with their counselor, paying careful attention to the prerequisites listed in the 2015 Summer School Guide. Registration materials will be available at the middle/high school from May 7th through May 22nd, Monday through Friday during normal school hours.

As you are aware, Jefferson County School District, is recovering from a budget deficit therefore this year we will only offer Algebra 1 and Biology 1 for remediation/credit recovery for course failure, extended learning year, and remediation courses (math/reading). All courses will be offered on campus and students are expected to be present each day for class and to arrive on time.

Due to the limited number of summer school seats available I ask that you sign up early so that we will have a good indication of how many students may want to attend summer school. This is an incredible opportunity for our students to get caught up and to get back on track with graduation, it is hoped that our course offerings will satisfy the needs of every family.

If you have any question about course offerings please contact your guidance counselor. All enrollment forms are due **by May 26th**. Forms turned after that date will not be accepted.
