FCAT Reading & Math and Stanford 10 2013-2014
Notification of Assessment Schedule for Home School Education

In compliance with Florida Statutes, parents of students enrolled in the Jefferson County Home School Program must provide an annual educational evaluation that documents each student's demonstration of educational progress at a level commensurate with his/her ability. A copy of the evaluation must be filed in the School Board Office each year. Standardized tests in reading and math that are administered by Jefferson County Schools may serve as your child's annual educational evaluation.

If you would like to have the evaluation completed during the regular administration of the standardized test used by the district, you should contact the appropriate school test coordinator according to the following schedule:

- FCAT tests are scheduled for **April 14 – May 1, 2014** for *grades 3 – 10*. Contact the test administrator by **April 7, 2014** if you wish for your child to take the FCAT.
- Stanford 10 testing for *grades K-2* is *tentatively* scheduled for **May 12 – 16, 2014**. Contact the test administrator by **April 7, 2014** if you wish for your child to take the Stanford 10.

The district does NOT administer a standardized test for grades 11-12. There is no fee charged for your child to complete the FCAT, but there is a \$15 fee (actual school district cost) for administering and scoring the Stanford 10 test.

The Jefferson County Elementary School (grades K-6) test coordinator is Mrs. Denese Hamilton, Guidance Counselor, phone # 342-0115. The Jefferson County Middle/High School test coordinator is Assistant Principal, Dr. Terrell Davis (grades 7-10), phone # 997-3555. Please make testing arrangements through the appropriate grade-level coordinator.

If you choose to use this service, you will need to transport the child to the school at a time determined by the test coordinator. Testing materials cannot be provided to the parent for administration. You are also reminded that the Superintendent may elect to review the portfolio of records and materials maintained for your child each school year.

If you have moved outside the district or have enrolled your child in a public or private school, please contact the Federal Programs Office at (850) 342-0100, ext. 218 so that we can maintain accurate records concerning your child's education.
